She was Director of Camp Allegro for 14 years since founding it in 1985 and is the author of the video/DVD *Music for Moms: Playing with Music*, introducing music concepts parents can explore through play with their children. Julie is a member of the Chicago Area Music Teachers Association and of Chicago Area Group Piano Pacesetters.
